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**1. Administration Building**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION**

*Funding is requested to construct a four-story central administration building on the south side of the campus. The University has never had a central administration building in its 108-year history. This request is consistent with the University Facilities Master Plan. The facility would consist of a four-story building (72,300 gross square feet) on the south side of the campus. The building would replace and expand existing administrative and faculty office. These offices are now scattered around campus.*

Delaware State University has an immediate need for a central administration building. Existing administrative functions are in many locations throughout the campus causing operational inefficiency. This has occurred as a result of short-term decisions in response to incremental growth over the past several decades. This building will result in increased operational efficiency and the ability to serve students better. The new building will be completely handicapped accessible, which will rectify the severe difficulties that exist with respect to accessibility to key student services. The location of the proposed administration building will result in minimal disruption to ongoing University activities. The resulting residual space will satisfy future academic needs consistent with the University Master Plan.

**2. Multi-Purpose Sports/Wellness Complex**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION**

*Funding is requested to construct and equip a comprehensive academic, fitness, wellness and sports complex inclusive of a weight training facility, office space for faculty and staff, meeting rooms for faculty, staff, students and medical personnel, and media facilities. The complex will include an outdoor track, auxiliary sports practice and playing facilities for football, which will accommodate 10,000 spectators, storage space for academic, intramural and athletic units, press and viewing boxes.*

In enhancing the University's ability to foster greater community involvement, the complex will allow the University to provide education and services which lead to lifetime fitness and wellness attitudes among campus and community constituents. Additionally, the facilities will allow for intramural programs designed for Delaware State University students, local colleges and high schools throughout the state. The facility can also host intra-state events, such as the high school wrestling championships, the state high school track championships, etc. The self-study conducted by Delaware State University for the NCAA Division I athletics certification program indicated the physical facilities for many programs are marginal in quantity and quality. The construction of a multi-purpose sports/wellness complex will alleviate the concerns expressed and help the athletic program achieve at a higher level.

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**4. Information Technology Building**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION**

*Funding is requested to construct a three-story academic/Management Information and Technology center for the campus. This request is consistent with the University Facilities Master Plan. The Information Technology Department will be the primary user of the building. This department is presently housed in the Luna I. Mishoe Science Center - North which was originally built for the sciences and the need for space to accommodate the continuing growth in their programs. The facility would consist of a three-story building with full usable basement space on the entire footprint of about 128,496 gross square feet on the center of the campus along the University Mall.*

Delaware State University is presently undergoing consolidation of use for space for functions of similar nature. The present location houses the mainframe for the university computer and telephone systems and the location of the Computer Sciences Department with the information and technology units which will be consolidated and completely centralized in the university's technology areas. The existing building was built in 1959 and would require extensive modification to meet the intended use. It is the university's plan to demolish the present building and add the additional spaces that will be required to meet the special needs for classroom space. The area that presently houses the Computer Center would be incorporated into the design and kept operational during this period. This building will also help rectify the present demand for space, increase operational efficiency and handicapped accessible.
