#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Funding is requested for the architectural design of an addition to the Delaware State Fire School at the existing New Castle County facility. This will accommodate the additional classes requested by the volunteer fire, rescue and emergency medical services. The existing space limits the classes conducted and creates a hardship when breakout sessions and practical sessions are required for student testing and participation. The demand for training increases each year and it has become extremely difficult for the Fire School to schedule the needed and requested training for the emergency responders of New Castle County.

The proposed addition would consist of an additional classroom, an office, lobby area and storage area. The addition will also permit staffing of the division during normal working hours with existing personnel.
