**1. Minor Capital Improvement and Equipment**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Funding is requested for the Minor Capital Improvement and Equipment (MCI) program to support ongoing maintenance and repair projects necessary for improving the safety of facilities used by military and civilian personnel, updating existing equipment and systems and supporting Delaware Army National Guard facilities. This includes replacement of heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems (HVAC), roofs, sidewalks, interior and exterior lighting, kitchens, washrooms and office space.

An additional \$880,000 is requested for life-safety improvements at the Scannell and Duncan Readiness Centers. Funds would be used to install fire alarm and fire suppression systems in both facilities.

There are currently 10 state-owned readiness centers, which, on average, were constructed 47 years ago. The eight oldest state-owned readiness centers were built between 1926 and 1977, for an average building age of 56 years.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Funding is requested to support the appropriated federal funds for the design and construction of a new vehicle maintenance shop in Dagsboro. Utilizing the design-build project delivery system, the existing vehicle maintenance shop will be demolished and a new one constructed in its place. The funds will be used for site preparation and to support the quality control and inspection services not funded by the National Guard Bureau to ensure complete project oversight and management.
