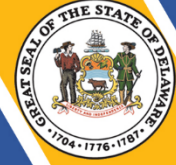


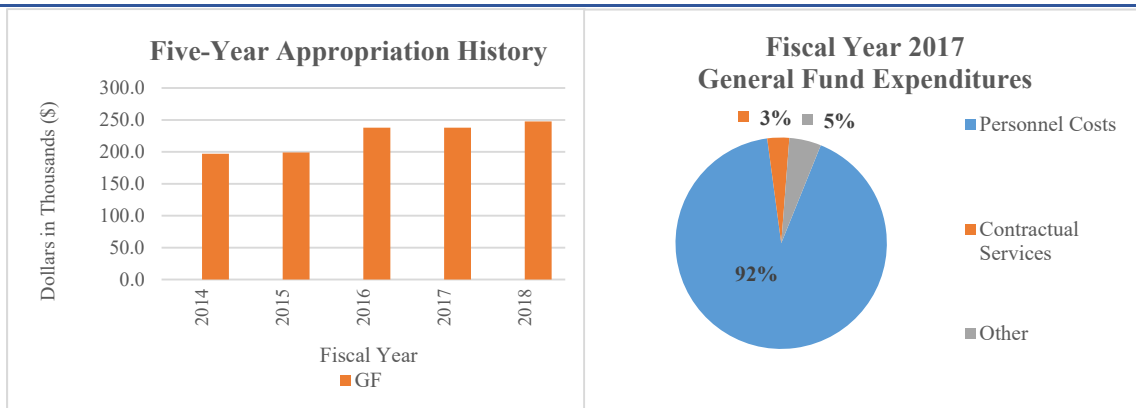
# Advisory Council for Exceptional Citizens



## At a Glance

- Provide 2,186 letters on legislation and regulations to elected officials and agencies on educational services and the service needs of individuals with exceptionalities;
- Participate on over 83 boards, councils, task forces and committees;
- Provide information to 52,600 individuals via Governor's Advisory Council for Exceptional Citizens (GACEC) presentations, press releases, newspaper articles, radio and television interviews, workshops and co-sponsorship of conferences around the State;
- Sponsor the DelAWARE DisABILITY Hub transition website which receives over 8,800 hits annually and provides information to over 6,400 unique visitors; and
- Act in an advisory capacity to the Department of Education and the Department of Correction, monitoring the provision of services in the joint agency prison education program.

## Overview

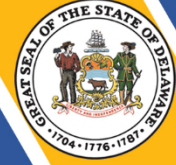
