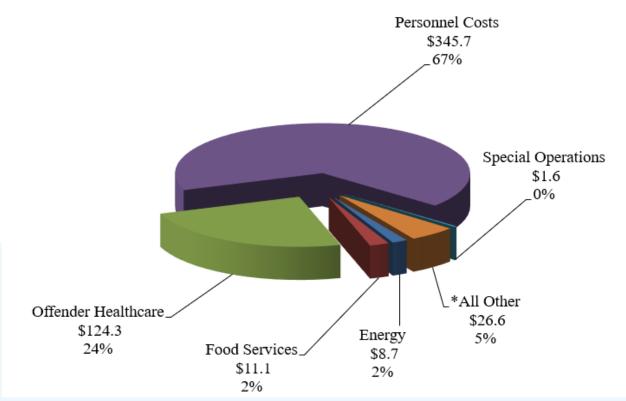
OPERATING BUDGET HISTORY



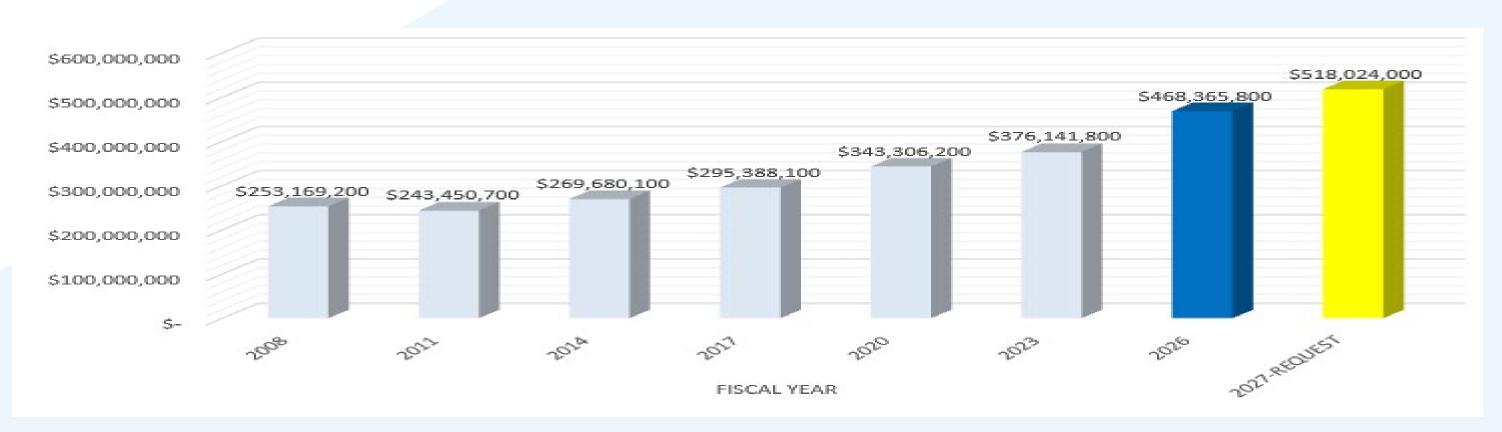

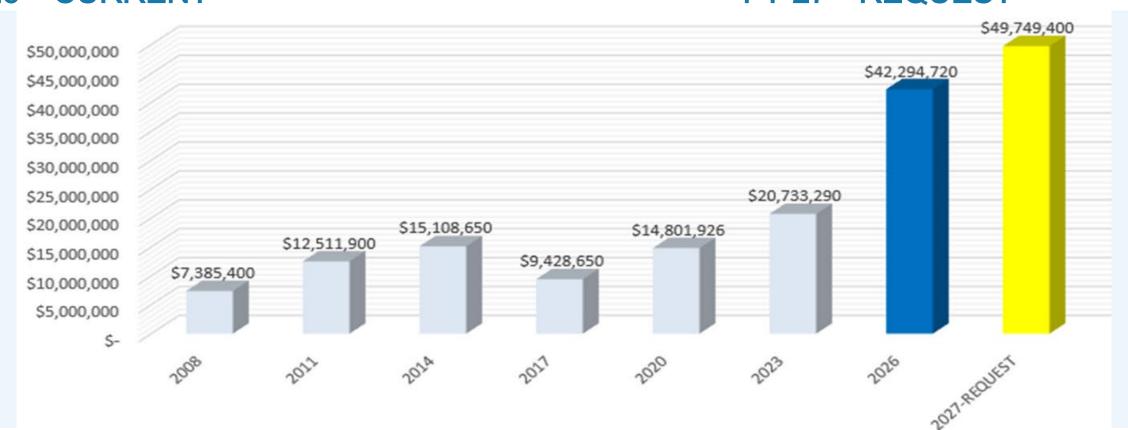
